Finance Manager Dodge reviewed the Statement of Obligations with the Commissioners and responded to questions.

### c) Review Cash Flow Report

Finance Manager Dodge reviewed the Cash Flow Report with the Commissioners.

Commissioner Webb moved to approve the Financial Statements and the Statement of Obligations as presented. Commissioner Roos seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0.
